How do these words land differently if Isaiah is hearing them from the perspective of his ability (v. 4a) versus God's character?

In what ways does God want to expand your understanding of what he is up to in your life? In what areas is he saying, "What you've been aiming for is too small a thing compared to what I want to do through you"?

- How does this land for you emotionally?
- What thoughts or questions does it spark?

In what areas of our church do you sense God is saying, "What you've been aiming for is too small a thing compared to what I want to do through you"?

- How can we say "yes" to what God wants to do through Risen King?
- In practical terms for you, what does that look like?
